
## **How Credit Card Processing Works**

The merchant sends the details to a payment processor through their payment gateway.

The card network communicates with the issuing bank, which approves or declines the transaction.

If the transaction is approved, the merchant charges the customer's card, and their purchase is complete.

The customer selects their payment method and provides their card number.

The payment processor communicates with the card network.

The issuing bank sends the merchant and card company notice of approval or denial.

The merchant deposits the approved payment amount to their bank and is credited the amount (minus processing fees).
